Tips and Strategy for IBPS Clerk

1. Firstly, you must reach the examination centre in time so as to avoid any trials and tribulations during the exam.
2. You must take care not to forget any documents as it can cost you your job.
3. You must read the instructions well before the examination (on the official site or in the official notification)
4. You must take mock tests in order to make sure that you are well prepared for the exam. Take an easy mock test before a day of the actual examination as high scores will boost your confidence.
5. You must revise all the basic rules and formulas that you already have practiced. You can also revise the vocabulary if you have prepared the list of the same.
6. If your exam does not fall in the first slot of the first shift, then you must check the analysis of the exam as it gives you the idea about the level and pattern of the questions being asked in the exam.
7. You must also check out the cut-off of the previous year and set a realistic goal of the number of attempts that you are going to do in the exam. (on the basis of the mock test and that must be more than previous year's cut-off)
8. You must not focus only on the maximum number of attempts but also on the accuracy of the answers marked. Sometimes, you are out of the race only due to the negative marking in the exam.
9. In all the sections, you must start from the topics in which you consistently score the best. It will benefit you in two ways. Firstly, you will be able to finish them in lesser time and more accuracy and secondly, it will boost up your morale as you will be left with lesser questions.
10. If you had a mindset regarding the number of attempts that you were going to make and the level of the exam differs from your expectations then you must not panic. It does not mean that you must not devise a strategy for the exam, it just means that you should follow a flexible approach for the exam where you can mould yourself in accordance with the pattern of the exam.

IMPORTANT: You must always pen down the number of sectional attempts that you make in the exam. It will help you to analyze your performance in the respective sections when the score card will be released.

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USAGES OF WILL AND SHALL

Difference Between the Usages of Will and Shall:

In accordance with the traditional grammar 'will' is used with names, **Second** and **Third** persons and 'shall' is used with the **First** persons only. i.e. I/We. But as per the modern English, these can be used interchangeably.

Thus, in expressing the future either 'will' or 'shall' can be used. But there are few situations where only one of them is appropriate.

USAGE OF 'SHALL'

- A.** 'Shall' can be used in the **second** and **third** person to express a **command, promise or threat**.

Examples:

1. You **shall** have a holiday tomorrow. (promise)
2. You **shall** pay for what you did to me. (threat)

- B.** Questions with 'Shall I' or 'Shall we' are used to ask the **opinion/will** of the person addressed.

Example:

Shall we start for home?

USAGE OF 'WILL'

- A.** 'Will' is used to express a characteristic habit.

Example:

She **will** talk about nothing else.

- B.** 'Will' is used to express 'volition'.

Example:

I **will** (am determined to) be on time tomorrow.

Note: **Volition** means a conscious choice/ decision.
