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SOME COMMON RULES USED IN ADVERBS

- Rule 1:** At the beginning of a sentence before the subject
 e.g. **Sometimes** she gives me a lift to work.
Fortunately we got home before it started to rain.
- Rule 2:** After the auxiliary verb and before the main verb
 e.g. The father was **tragically** killed in a road accident.
 We do **occasionally** go bird-watching.
- Rule 3:** After the auxiliary verb (be) that is used as the main verb
 e.g. She is **always** quick to point out other people's faults.
 As usual, they are **very** late.
- Rule 4:** Before the main verb if there is no auxiliary verb
 e.g. Their parents **often** go to the cinema.
 She **reluctantly** agreed to his proposals.
- Rule 5:** After the main verb if there is no auxiliary verb
 e.g. The sisters dressed **beautifully** for the occasion.
 The tourist looked **carefully** at the antique before she bought it.
- Rule 6:** At the end of a sentence
 e.g. He admitted punching and kicking the man **repeatedly**.
 Our old neighbor fell and hurt her leg **badly**.
- Rule 7:** Before Adjectives and other adverbs
 e.g. Lata sings very **sweetly**.
 It is **very** hot today.
- Rule 8:** Adverbs of quantity such as- too, very, quite, completely etc are generally used before adjectives or adverbs.
 e.g. He is **too** weak.; You run **very** fast.
- Rule 9:** Adverbs of place such as- here, there, everywhere etc are used after verbs or in the last of the sentence.
 e.g. He comes **here**.; He lives **there**.
- Rule 10:** Adverbs of time such as- Yesterday, today, tomorrow etc are used after verbs or in the last of the sentence.
 e.g. He will come **tomorrow**.; His grandfather died **yesterday**.

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
